Our cities are increasingly being affected by climate change.

Higher air temperatures, less precipitation, heavy rain events, and flooding will increase in the coming years.

In the last few years, different areas of the World Heritage City of Quedlinburg have already been flooded after extremely heavy rains.

The World Heritage City of Quedlinburg is therefore seeking ideas from landscape architecture students to increase the resilience of this unique medieval city

The historic Old Town of Quedlinburg is one of the largest areas in Germany that stands under historic monument protection. The aim of the competition is to develop ideas, such as the principal of sponge city, that improve the urban climate and can be implemented in this medieval stone town structure. How can rain water retention, surface unsealing, infiltration, and evaporation be applied here?

- Participation is limited to landscape architecture students in Saxony, Saxony Anhalt and Thuringia.
- Cooperation and exchange with students from other programs is encouraged.
- Students may work in teams of two.
- Ideas and concepts are to be presented on two A0 sheets.
- The competition announcement will be in German and English.
- Work can be presented in German or English.
- The competition announcement and competition results will be presented on the platform *Competition Online*.
- Attendance of the colloquium in Quedlinburg on 05.11.2021 is required.
